Annual international Contest of Architectural ideas for Siberia

Provision of the contest ARCH_TAIGA 2016



Introduction

One of the main attractions of the city is the island-park Tatyshev. It is a picturesque part of the city, isolated by the river Yenisey. According to official statistics, about 100,000 people visit the island every week during warm seasons.

There is a well-developed infrastructure in the Park: sports equipment rental centre, lots of cafes, playgrounds for kids of all ages, running tracks, bicycle tracks, roller-skating tracks of total length more than 5 km. There are basketball and volleyball courts, playgrounds with grass and hard surface. There are also gymnastic sets, tennis courts and an area for playing table tennis, extreme sports playground. During winter time there are also lots of visitors in the Park and there are many opportunities for going in for sports or relaxing.

There are ski-runs of total length 10 km and the biggest ice-skating rink in the city. The rink is not only one of the most popular places of public amusement, but also an open air field for hosting different public events.

During last years Tatyshev Park has become a sort of a city brand, connected with the ideas of healthy lifestyle, focus on ecology and realization of big ideas and initiatives. The Park has become the centre of family and active outdoor activities of the city.

The island coordinates: lat 56° 1'38.65"C, long 92°56'37.27"B.





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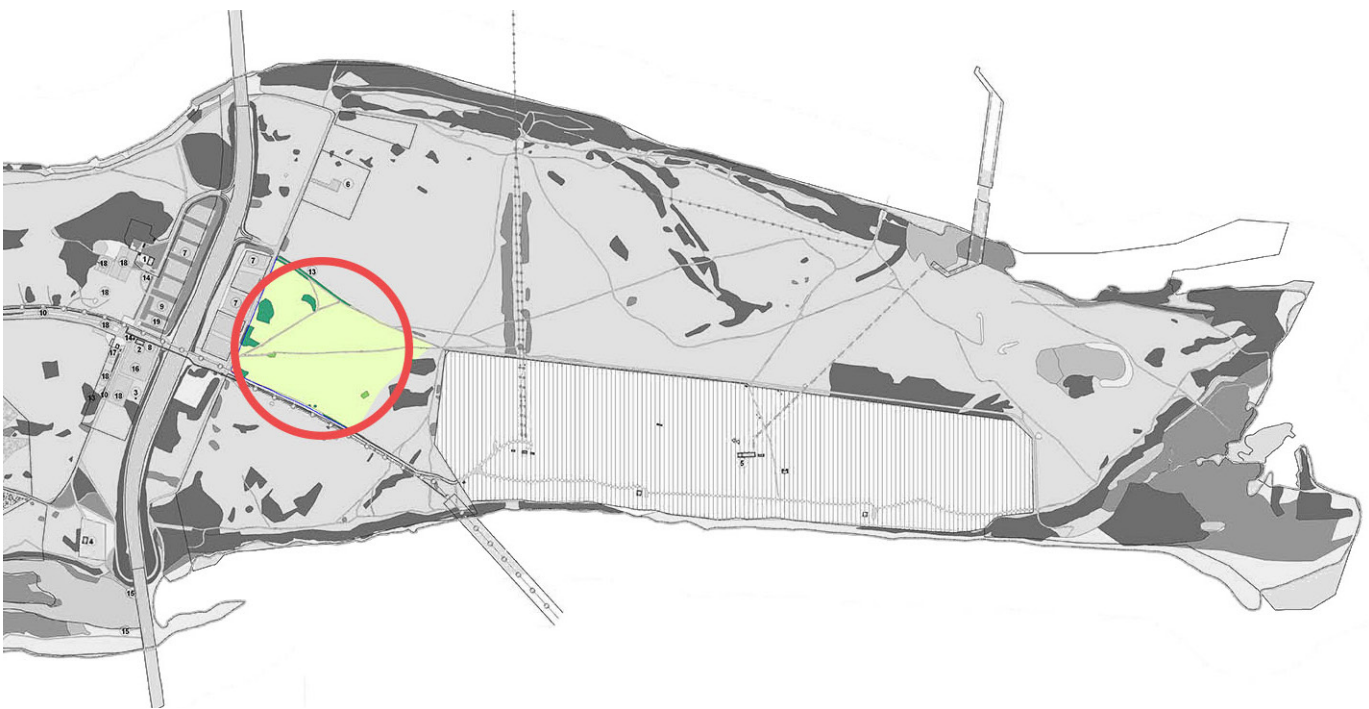
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Offer

The main task of the contestants is to work out the project of an ice palace (winter amusement park), situated on one of the main playgrounds of Tatyshchev island, which will become popular among citizens of Krasnoyarsk and also will attract tourist flow during Winter Universiade which will take place in Krasnoyarsk in 2019. The project should correspond to the needs of the target audience, visiting the island: families, young people, pensioners.

Due to climatic characteristics of the region, while developing the project (namely, infrastructure facilities) it is preferable to take into account the possibility of using ice and snow. Winter temperatures are usually below -15 C, and such temperature is altogether 5-6 months of the year. The snow part of the Park can add spice to the project and attract more people during winter time. The part of the construction, made of snow and ice, can be rebuilt annually, its interiors can be reformed and it will let artists and architects of the city to express themselves, working out new themes in the snow part of the Park. There are similar snow parks in other countries, such as Finland and Thailand.

The infrastructure of the snow park will include: ice bar, restaurants and cafes, snow amusements, ice bowling, museum-exhibition areas, playgrounds for kids, labyrinths etc. This list is up to contestants to decide. Below you can find the list of elements recommended by the organizers.





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Rules of contest participation

Minimal recommended set of elements of infrastructure and service:

- Café-bar 100 sq.m
- Shopping and entertainment zone 200 sq.m
- WC 50 sq.m
- Administration block 30 sq.m
- Security desk 10 sq.m
- Equipment block 100 sq.m
- Staff room 100 sq.m
- Other service premises for the Park maintenance (at contestants' discretion).

Quadrature can be changed a little in accordance with contestants' desire.

The objects, which were not made of ice and snow, should have the possibility to function in warm seasons. Operating safety of amusement park and other elements of construction is one of the crucial components of the project.

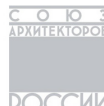
According to the concept of "ARCH_TAIGA" not only professionals, such as architects, city planners, designers, but also amateurs can take part in the contest. The contestants can be either individuals or groups of people including specialists from related fields.

There is no registration fee in the contest.

For registration every contestant or a team has to download a registration form from the site, fill it in, and save in the DOC format. After filling in the form it should be sent to the mail archtaigacontest@gmail.com, in the letterhead please type "Application ARCH_TAIGA 2016 – contestants' name and surname". In the letter of response the contestants will get an individual code in the format of №0000000000, which should be placed at the presentation board and in the explanatory note. The contestant's name and surname should not be mentioned on the presentation board or in the explanatory note, and only contest organizers know the name till posting contest results.

The place on the presentation board, left for the contestant's individual code is indicated on the model of the presentation board in the right lower corner on the grey field under the "ARCH_TAIGA" logotype. The code on the presentation board should be easily recognizable regardless of the project presentation. You can download the presentation board model from the project website (section "DOWNLOAD"). The file is available in PSD and JPG formats. Grey field in the presentation board should by no means be changed, covered or moved, otherwise the project will be disqualified.

The system of individual codes guarantees contestants' anonymity and impartiality of jury work. **In case there is no individual code on the presentation board or in the explanatory note in the designated place, or there is a full name together with the code or instead of it, such projects will not be accepted to the contest.**





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Project composition and layout

The project consists of two parts.

- **Explanatory note (2 to 10 pages of A4);** You can download the model of explanatory note in the "DOWNLOAD" section of our site.

- **Presentation board** (the list with the main graphical information about the project. The sheet of Din A1 (841 x 594 mm or 33.1 x 23.4 inches). You can download the board in the "DOWNLOAD" section of our site.

The explanatory note should include the following: general information, the conception of architectural forming, layout and arrangement, building construction and materials, utility system, conclusion.

On the presentation board you should designate:

- **General plan.** The plan of site landscaping, the arrangement of hardscape, gaming and sport equipment;

- **Accessory drawings.** Floor plans, sections, developed views, units of structural elements.

- **Project design visualization.** Perspective drawing of the complex or its individual elements. Any drawing is accepted, either made by hand or 3D model.

The designer can include any information considered as necessary into the project.

The "ARCH_TAIGA" contest logo and the individual code should be at the presentation board. The contestant should download the presentation board model with the "ARCH_TAIGA" logo already included and the marked place for his/her individual code.

Removal, relocation or covering of the "ARCH_TAIGA" logo or the individual number by other elements will result in contestant's disqualification.

You can download the presentation board model from the project site (section "DOWNLOAD"). The file is available in the formats PSD, JPG.

Sending projects

Contestants should send the presentation board in JPG format in original resolution and the explanatory note in DOC format to the e-mail archtaigacontest@gmail.com, in the letterhead please type "Application ARCH_TAIGA 2016 – contestant's name and surname". Additionally contestants should send their photos in TIF format, 300 dpi, size 10x15 cm for possible publication in mass media after the announcement of the contest results.

After all the materials are sent the contestants will get the message from the contest organizers within three working days confirming his participation in the contest. In case the confirmation letter has not been received it is possible to send the project once again.





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Jury

Contest jury comprises 9 members.

The jury comes to a decision on a consensus basis. In case it cannot be obtained, the vote is held among jury members and thus the winner is defined.

Jury assesses the projects according to the following criteria:

- Originality and design quality;
- Compliance with the contest aims;
- Integration into environment;
- Operation safety of the complex;
- The way the project is presented to the contest

Information regarding the place and date of awarding winners will be placed on the project web-site and in social networking sites after the announcement of contest results.
